Thank you for the prayers, cards, notes, and calls during my recent surgery. I am doing well and feeling better each day.

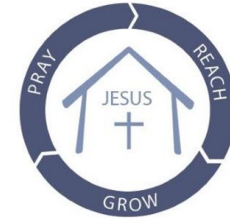
